National Trails Day is organized by the American Hiking Association. This day is a celebration of our nation wide trail system and all of its supporters and volunteers. More than 1,500 events will take place across the country and will include trail maintenance, hiking, paddling, biking, bird watching running and trail celebrations. The official date for NTD is June 5th. Our hike is planned for June 6th from 2-4pm and is registered as one of the events with the American Hiking association. The walk will take about 1½ hrs. and will cover the geology, terrain, history, tree species, plant materials and wildlife habitats that we will encounter. NTD began in 1993. Its purpose is to “promote healthy living, physical and mental well being, protect green space, educate youth and adults on the importance of trails and instill excitement for the outdoors.” This year’s theme is “**FIND YOUR HAPPY PLACE**”.
